I am requesting funding for Judson and Lookout Roads Low Water Crossing Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of San Antonio, located at 100 W Houston San Antonio, TX 78205. The funding would be used to address recurring roadway flooding at the intersection of Judson and Lookout Road in San Antonio, Texas.
