Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Manor for Waterline Replacement Project - Intermediate Tank to Downtown Water Plant in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 105 E. Eggleston St. Manor, TX 78653. The funding would be used to upsize an aging 12-inch transmission main to a 16-inch pipeline between the intermediate storage tank and downtown water plant to improve system capacity. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the pipeline serves as a critical link to deliver water from well field storage into the City's central distribution network and has experienced maintenance issues and capacity limitations in recent years to reliably serve the City's expanding population.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
