I am requesting funding for the City of Manor for Waterline Replacement Project - Well Field to Intermediate Tank in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 105 E. Eggleston St. Manor, TX 78653. The funding would be used to replace the shallow 12-inch transmission line from well field to intermediate tank with a 16-inch pipeline installed at proper depth in protected easements. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the new transmission pipeline will significantly improve the reliability and resilience of the City's groundwater supply system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
